AWARD AMOUNT: \$1,500

Application Instructions and Eligibility (WWW.CCEF.ORG/SCHOLARSHIP)

Deadline: *all application materials must be submitted via email by March 1, 202x*

Eligibility: Any Clan Campbell member who has graduated from high school, or will receive a high school diploma by June 202x, and will attend an accredited college, or trade and certificate program, is eligible to apply. Clan Campbell members are defined as descendants, of the Ancient and Honorable Clan Campbell of Scotland, who came to North America from Scotland, and their spouses; and descendants of others of the surname Campbell, a recognized Clan Campbell Sept name, and their spouses. Variations in the spelling of Campbell or a Campbell Sept name shall not make anyone ineligible.

Exclusions: Members of the immediate families of the current CCEF Board of Directors and the Scholarship Selection Committee are not eligible to apply.

Requirements:

1. A completed application form. Names and birthplaces of parents and grandparents, clearly indicating Clan Campbell family lineage, must be provided in the application.
2. A 500-word (minimum), typed essay, research article or business proposal on one of the following topics:
 - An article about a CC ancestor whose life experience has particular cultural or scientific significance. Applicants who choose this option should review the archives at www.ccef.org/scholarship in order to not duplicate research that has already been done. A password is needed to access the archive. Email membership@ccsna.org to request a temporary password or to purchase a regular CCSNA membership for \$35. (Note: Essays on Clan Campbell that don't contain fresh information are particularly discouraged.)
 - Research that expands the Clan Campbell's current genealogical data. Applicants who choose this option are strongly advised to contact the CCSNA Genealogist, genealogist@ccsna.org, to discuss the topic *before* beginning research.
 - A practical and well-considered proposal for expansion of Clan Campbell membership to a new generation, including innovative ideas for program activities.
 - A personal essay on "What My Clan Campbell Scottish Heritage Means To Me."
3. Essays must be original and will be checked for plagiarism. Essays generated using AI are disqualified.

The application and essay must be submitted as attachments to an email and sent to www.ccsna.org/ccef/scholarship. The applicant's name should NOT be included on the essay pages. The essay should be titled.

Announcement of Award: The award announcement will be made on April 30, 202x and will appear on the CCEF web site at www.CCEF.org and in the Summer 2023 Clan Campbell Education Foundation Newsletter. The award recipient will be contacted by telephone and will be asked at that time to provide a letter of acceptance from an accredited college or certificate program. Payment will be issued directly to the college/trade school and may be used for tuition, room and board, or expenses. Funds not used for study during the 202x-2x academic year will be forfeited.
